

MILO MANNERS FAQ

How do I enroll?

Since our classes are open enrollment, all you need to do is reserve a spot at least 24 hours before the next class by emailing training@milofoundation.org . Then you'd make payment at Milo with one of our front end staff members.

How does open enrollment work?

We understand that most people are busy so if you miss a class you don't lose a class. The way classes are structured, we cover new ground each time so we don't repeat material. For each class to work we need at least 2 sign ups.

When do classes run?

Puppy classes run every Saturday from 10am-11am

Adult classes run every Saturday from 11:30am-12:30pm

Where are classes held?

Puppy classes are held in our concrete yard which is deep cleaned and sanitized. Adult classes are held at our Milo park just a block down from our facility.

How old does my puppy need to be to be enrolled?

Puppies must be over 8 weeks of age and younger than 5 months old with at least 2 vaccines to enroll into puppy class. Puppies over 5 months should be in Adult class.

How much do the classes cost?

\$100 for Milo dogs

\$125 for non Milo dogs

This covers 4 classes

What are some of the reasons class may be cancelled?

Classes are primarily cancelled due to weather, especially in the winter. Holidays , insufficient number of sign ups, and emergencies may be other reasons. Cancelled classes will be marked on our website's calendar.

I have a foster dog, can I do classes?

Yes! Classes are free for both fosters and volunteers 😊

I don't have a Milo dog. Do I need to show vaccine history?

Yes, we ask that you bring a current health record for your dog so we can make sure everyone is up to date 😊
